This guide provides an overview of the key steps to subdividing land.

Individual situations vary and Land Victoria encourages the use of a conveyancer or lawyer to manage, prepare and lodge the application for registration of a plan of subdivision.

## Subdividing land

Title search	A current copy of the title and plan diagram of the land to be subdivided is required for initial discussions with the licensed land surveyor and/or council. Licensed land surveyor	A licensed surveyor is required to survey the land and prepare the plan that council needs to certify. Council	Council receives the plan of subdivision from the licensed surveyor for certification. It considers the application, refers the plan to the relevant authorities and ensures all relevant requirements have been met. Conveyancer or lawyer	The conveyancer or lawyer organises all relevant documents (including Certificate(s) of Title) and prepares relevant forms to lodge at Land Victoria. ## Guide to steps in the subdivision process

Land Victoria	All documents are lodged at Land Victoria and examined.	Lodgement is at Plan Acceptance, Land Victoria.
	All parties must satisfy the verification of identity requirements.  When all of Land Victoria's requirements are satisfied, the plan is registered and new Certificate(s) of Title are issued to the relevant parties.
